

Board Meeting Minutes
Maine Prairie Township
May 10, 2022

Unspent CARES Act Dollars transferred to the County (\$18,910.00): The County to decide how the remaining unspent CARES Act dollars will be spent.

Weed Spraying Contract: Contract with AIP executed by Township and will be sent to AIP for their signature. Start date for work to be done to be agreed upon by the parties.

Chloride Roads: Dust Guarding to begin the end of May.

Approve Reorganization Minutes: Motion by Supervisor Loewen/Chair Wicker to accept and continue the Reorganization Chart presented with one change. All in favor, motion carried.

Road Projects in 2022: Road projects are scheduled to begin soon.
